Resolution

The academic year 2020-2021: Determining the terms of administrative registration and the academic calendar

By paragraph 9 of Article 9, subparagraph 4.1 of the Statute of the Georgian Aviation University and Articles 3 and 9 of the Regulations governing the educational process of the Georgian Aviation University, LLC.

I'm Ordering:

1) To determine the conditions of the academic (registration for the respective academic course of the educational program) and administrative (tuition fees according to the agreement) at "The Aviation University of Georgia" LLC for the first (autumn) and second (spring) semester of 2020-2021 academic year:

1.1. the first (autumn) semester:

1.1.1 For students of all four-year programs of Georgian and English languages, 2nd year of masters degree, and all three years of doctoral studies:

A) Academic Registration - from August 24, 2020, to September 4 including;

B) Administrative Registration - from 7 to 11 September 2020.

1.1.2. For first-year students:

A) Academic registration - from 24 August 2020 to 4 September including;

B) Administrative registration - from 7 to 11 September 2020.

C) Academic (registration for the relevant training course of the educational program) registration - from 14 to 18 September 2020;

D) Administrative (payment of tuition fees according to the agreement) registration - from September 21 to September 25, 2020.

1.2 In the second (spring) semester:

1.2.1. For students of all four years of study in the Georgian and English Bachelors, 2nd Master and 3rd Doctoral programs:

A) Academic registration - from 1 to 12 February 2021;

B) Administrative Registration - from February 15, 2021, to February 19, 2021.

1.2.2. For 2nd semester postgraduate students:

A) Academic registration - from February 12 to February 25, 2021;

B) Administrative Registration - February 26, 2021.

2. In the first semester of the 2020-2021 academic year:

Students of all four-year programs of Georgian and English, two-year postgraduate and three-year doctoral studies start on September 14, 2020, and the first year of postgraduate studies starts on October 5, 2020, and ends on October 5, 2020:

A) For students of all four years of Georgian and English Bachelor's and Master's degree programs, the second year of postgraduate studies and three years of doctoral studies - February 5, 2021;

B) for the first year of Master's degree students - February 26, 2021;

2. 1. As per the curriculum:

A) Intermediate examinations will be held for students of all four bachelor courses of Georgian and English languages, the second year of master's degree and three-year doctoral studies from November 2 to November 13, 2020, as well as final examinations from January 18 to February 5, 2021;

B) Intermediate examinations for first-year Master's students will be held from 23 November to 4 December 2020, and final examinations from 8 to 26 February 2021.

3. The second term of the academic year 2019-2020:

A) Studying for students of all four years of study in Georgian and English Bachelor's, 2nd year of Master's, and 3rd year of Doctoral studies should start on February 22, 2021, and end on July 2. Intermediate exams will be held from April 12 to 23, and final exams from June 14 to July 2;

B) The first year of the master's degree course must begin on 1 March 2021 and end on 9 July. The intermediate examinations will be held from 19 to 30 April and the final examinations from 21 June to 9 July;

C) Qualification documents for students in the 8th semester of the Georgian and English language programs, the 4th semester of the Master's program, and the 6th semester of the Doctorate program should be protected from June 14 to July 2.

4. Instruct the university administration to bring order to the faculties and interested persons.

5. To instruct the public relations manager to place the order on the official website of the University;

6. The order can be appealed in accordance with the rules established by law within one month after its entry into force. Tbilisi City Court (Address: Tbilisi, David Agmashenebeli Alley, 12 km, 6);

7. The order shall enter into force upon signature.
